While staying at BIAM, you have to follow the strict rules and regulations of the Institution. **Any case of misconduct will be dealt severely.** In case of major violation of rules and norms a participant may end up being released from training course. In such case BIAM shall send report and request to the authority to start disciplinary action against the participant. However, your positive approach, mental readiness and the determination to cope with the training workload are fundamental for your success. Please note that you have to attend morning PT regularly.

4.03 During SFTC you may have to observe important festival or national days. Therefore, you need to bring appropriate dresses for the events.

4.04 BIAM will arrange your accommodation and food during your stay at the venue. The cost incurred for your food during your stay at BIAM will be met from the training budget. Pregnant participants are discouraged to attend the training course. Female participants having babies (staying at BIAM) have to pay for BIAM hostel rent and food from own pocket.

4.05 Please bring four (4) copies of your recent colored passport size & two (2) copies stamp size colored photographs for registration & other purposes. You are also requested to bring your necessary personal medicine.

4.06 Participants are not allowed to keep precious ornaments, valuables or large sum of money in the dormitory.

4.07 You have to **report at Reception Desk, BIAM Foundation Regional Center, Cox's Bazar on 7th February, 2022 (Monday) by 6:00 pm.** In case of failure to report as instructed, that participant will not be allowed to attend the training course.

4.08 A Briefing Session has been scheduled at **8.00 pm 7th February**, **2022** (Monday). Inaugural Ceremony is scheduled at **10.00 am** on **8th February**, **2022**. All participants have to take their seats at the Hall Room/Classroom 10 minutes earlier to the scheduled time.

4.09 You shall not get leave BIAM during training (except emergency situation subject to approval of the authority).

4.10 You have to strictly adhere to Health safety and personal hygiene codes during pandemic (COVID 19).

4.11 Please bring your personal Laptop if any. BIAM has Wi-Fi and printing facility for participants.
